

## JURIED PORTFOLIO REVIEW GUIDELINES

If you are participating in the portfolio contest, please make sure you follow the guidelines below.

### **Artwork Parameters**

**Portfolio** (standard formats only)

Only one (1) portfolio permitted

Size: Up to 15" width & height, depth proportional to a flat portfolio within the above proportions Length: 12-15 pages suggested

Please make sure your name is included in your portfolio

**Promotional Postcards** (To be placed by your portfolio) **Amount:** up to 20 suggested- only one set permitted.

**Size:** up to 5 x 7 inches.

Submit your cards either in a rubber band or in a disposable bag and the cards will be displayed on the table by your piece. No cardholders please. We cannot ensure their safety or return. Please include your name and contact information.

**Dummy** (Mockup Book) Optional; not a requirement

Only one (1) Dummy permitted. It **MUST** be securely attached to your portfolio (string or ribbon suggested). This means of attachment is not an option, but a requirement if you bring a dummy. Please arrive to the check in table with your dummy already attached to your portfolio. Thank you.

### **Please note what is not permitted**

The following will disqualify your portfolio from judging. Disqualified portfolios can still be displayed during Arts, Eats and Autographs, but will not be accepting for jurying.

- Oversized portfolios (whether in length, depth or width) Non-secured portfolio (images not securely attached to portfolio)
- Original art
- Framed art
- Published books (You may, of course, display spreads from your published books within your portfolio, if you wish.)
- 3-dimensional art
- Easels, stands or props of any kind
- Portfolios in unusual novelty formats, such as boxes

Please have your attendance badge with you when you drop off your portfolio. All portfolio entries must be hand-carried and dropped off and signed in between 5:00 and 5:30pm on Saturday September 17<sup>th</sup> at the conference registration table, and picked up and signed out the following morning at the same location between (7:30am-8:00am). Portfolios not picked up during this time will be stored at the registration desk. Their safety or return is not guaranteed. If you are not attending the conference on Sunday, let us know so we can make special arrangements to have you pick up your portfolio Saturday night.

When dropping off your piece for the exhibition, you must also sign a copy of the 2016 SCBWI Juried Portfolio Release Form provided at check-in. **NO ART WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THIS SIGNED RELEASE.**
